

Powertex Treasure Tree by Kore Sage



Ingredients


- Powertex Universal Medium (dark colour)
- 1mm craft wire
- Fabric strips and scraps
- 3d balls in large and medium
- A base for your tree
- Black Bister spray
- Easy Varnish
- Copper Colortricx
- Mixing plate
- Paper towel
- Flat brush





STEP 1

- Create the wire armature
- Fold the loop to form the base
- Twist the branches for thickness
- Arrange branches horizontally



STEP 2

- Fix the wire tree to a base
- Use masking tape to cover the wire frame
- Ensure the whole frame is covered



STEP 3

- Wrap fabric strips coated in Powertex
- Create lots of texture with the fabric
- Add textures to the base with fabric and balls



STEP 4

- Allow to dry
- Spray with black bister for depth
- Dry brush with Easy Varnish and Copper Colortricx for highlights
- Add tiny treasures to the branches!
